Tips and tricks

- Chase Ultimate Rewards currently has transfer bonuses of 30% to British Airways and 40% to Virgin Atlantic.
- There are numerous award booking options for LATAM business class, mainly with Oneworld and SkyTeam partner airlines.
- British Airways Executive Club is one of several airline loyalty programs that use the Avios currency, along with Aer Lingus, Finnair, Iberia and Qatar Airways. If you have Avios with any of these programs, you can move those rewards to any other Avios program.
- You can currently transfer American Express
 Membership Rewards points to Alaska
 Airlines Mileage Plan by first transferring
 them to Hawaiian Airlines HawaiianMiles,
 then transferring those HawaiianMiles to
 Mileage Plan.

Step-by-step instructions




- 1. Visit the Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan site and log in to your account.
- 2. Enter the origin and destination airports.
- 3. Use the Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan award calendar to find the relevant dates.
- 4. Call Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan to verify the award space and hold the seats.
- 5. Transfer points if needed (this usually happens instantly).
- 6. Book the flight.

Notes:

• There are up to nine business-class seats available per flight.
