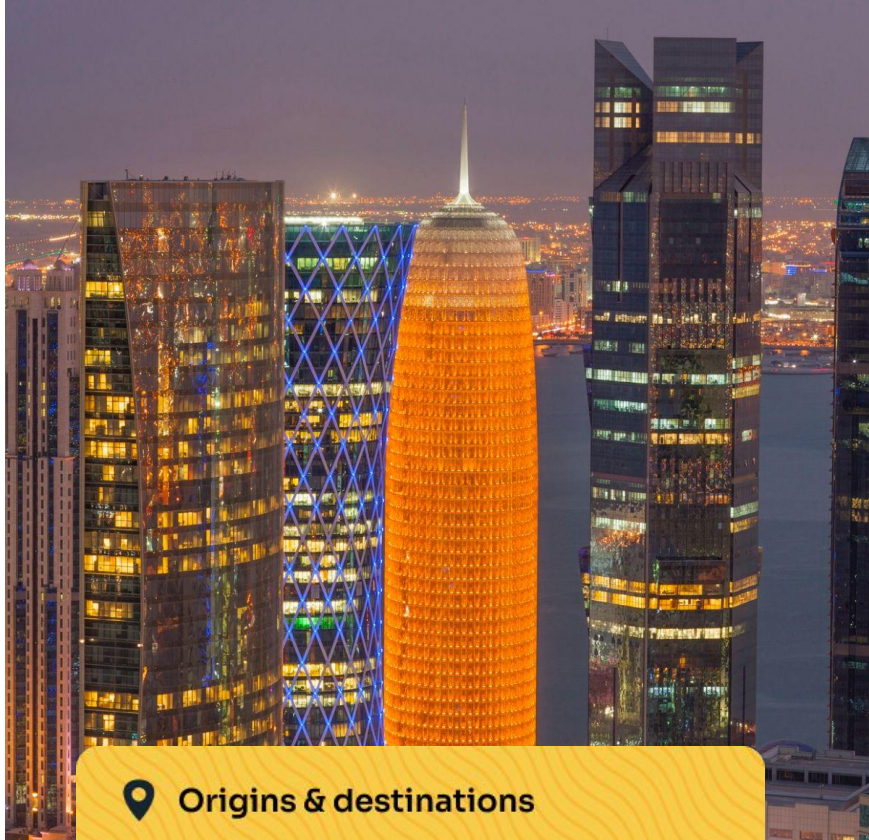

## Where to book



### Qatar Airways

**Avios:** 70,000 one-way (**54,000 Chase points** with 30% transfer bonus)

**Taxes, fees & surcharges:** \$100

**Transfer partners:** American Express, Citi and other Avios programs

### British Airways Executive Club

**Avios:** 70,000 one-way (**54,000 Chase points** with 30% transfer bonus)

**Taxes, fees & surcharges:** \$100

**Transfer partners:** American Express, Bilt, Capital One, Chase, Wells Fargo and other Avios programs

### American Airlines AAdvantage

**Miles:** 70,000 one-way

**Taxes, fees & surcharges:** \$56

**Transfer partners:** None

### JetBlue TrueBlue

**Points:** 90,000 one-way

**Taxes, fees & surcharges:** \$50

**Transfer partners:** American Express, Chase and Citi

## Tips and tricks



- There are numerous options for booking Qatar Airways' Qsuite. You can book directly with Qatar Airways or through Oneworld alliance partners and other partner airlines.
- Taxes and fees are lowest when booking with American Airlines or JetBlue. But Qatar Airways and British Airways have the most options for transferring in rewards from other programs.
- Qatar Airways Privilege Club is one of several airline loyalty programs that use the Avios currency, along with Aer Lingus, British Airways, Finnair and Iberia. If you have Avios with any of these programs, you can move those rewards to any other Avios program.
- Chase Ultimate Rewards currently has a **30% transfer bonus** to British Airways, Iberia and Aer Lingus, meaning you could book this flight for as little as **54,000 Chase points**.

## Step-by-step instructions



1. Visit the Qatar Airways Privilege Club site and log in to your account.
2. Enter the origin and destination airports.
3. Enter the desired date, but select "flexible dates."
4. Use the Qatar Airways award calendar to find the relevant dates.
5. Transfer points (this usually happens instantly).
6. Move Avios between programs (if necessary).
7. Book the flight.

**Notes:**

- There are up to two Qsuite business-class seats available per flight.
- This is a new route recently announced by Qatar Airways which uses a Boeing 777-300ER aircraft.
