Where to book



Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan

Miles: 45,000–55,000 one-way, depending on departure date and airport

Taxes, fees & surcharges: \$19

Transfer partners: Bilt, American Express (via Hawaiian Airlines HawaiianMiles)

British Airways Executive Club

Avios: 50,000–60,000 one-way, or as few as **42,000 Capital One miles** with a 20% transfer bonus

Taxes, fees & surcharges: \$150

Transfer partners: American Express, Bilt, Capital One, Chase, Wells Fargo and other Avios programs

United Airlines MileagePlus

Miles: 88,000

Taxes, fees & surcharges: \$6

Transfer partners: Bilt, Chase

Tips and tricks



- Aer Lingus AerClub uses the Avios currency, as do British Airways Executive Club, Finnair Plus, Iberia Plus and Qatar Airways Privilege Club. If you have Avios with any of these programs, you can move those rewards to any other Avios program.
- There are numerous award booking options for Aer Lingus business class through the Avios program, Oneworld partners and other partner airlines.
- You can get a 20% bonus when you [transfer Capital One miles to British Airways Executive Club](#). You can also transfer [American Express Membership Rewards points to Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan](#) by first transferring them to Hawaiian Airlines, then transferring those HawaiianMiles to Mileage Plan.

Step-by-step instructions



1. Visit the Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan site and log in to your account.
2. Enter the origin and destination airports.
3. Use the Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan award calendar to find the relevant dates.
4. Call Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan to verify the award space and hold the seats.
5. Transfer miles if needed (this usually happens instantly).
6. Book the flight.

Notes:

- There are up to four business-class seats available per flight.
- Some routes operate the Airbus A321neo, which is a single-aisle aircraft.
