## Where to book



### Avianca LifeMiles

**Miles:** 65,000 one-way from the East Coast, or **56,600 American Express points** with 15% transfer bonus/69,000 from SFO

**Taxes, fees & surcharges:** \$30

**Transfer partners:** American Express, Bilt, Capital One, Citi and Wells Fargo

### Air Canada Aeroplan

**Points:** 60,000/70,000 one-way

**Taxes, fees & surcharges:** \$50

**Transfer partners:** American Express, Bilt, Capital One and Chase

### United MileagePlus

**Miles:** 88,000 one-way

**Taxes, fees & surcharges:** \$6

**Transfer partners:** Bilt and Chase

### ANA Mileage Club

**Miles:** 100,000 round-trip

**Taxes, fees & surcharges:** \$60

**Transfer partners:** American Express

## Tips and tricks



- There are many award-booking options for TAP business class, mainly with Star Alliance partner airlines.
- American Express Membership Rewards points currently come with a **15% transfer bonus** to Avianca LifeMiles, which means you could book this flight for as little as **56,600 Amex points**.
- Avianca LifeMiles+ subscribers get a 10% discount on partner award bookings
- Holders of the **Aeroplan® Credit Card** from Chase get an extra 10% on the transfer of Chase Ultimate Rewards points to Air Canada Aeroplan.
- The TAP Airbus A321neo LR is a single-aisle aircraft. While the seats are lie-flat, they are arranged in a 2-2/1-1 layout and do not provide aisle access for all passengers. This aircraft is primarily used on East Coast routes.

## Step-by-step instructions



1. Visit the Avianca LifeMiles site, [lifemiles.com](https://lifemiles.com), and sign in to your account.
2. Select "Travel" to find the award-booking portal.
3. Enter the origin and destination airports.
4. Leave the date field blank.
5. Use the Avianca LifeMiles award calendar to find the relevant dates.
6. Call Avianca LifeMiles to verify the award space and hold the seats.
7. Transfer points if needed (this usually happens instantly).
8. Book the flight.

**Notes:**

- There are up to nine business-class seats available per flight.
- When booking through Avianca LifeMiles, it can be tricky to find space due to the program's clunky search tool.
- Instead, consider first checking for availability through [United Airlines' website](#), where you can see availability month by month. You can then cross-check these dates with Avianca or Air Canada to book the cheaper rate.
- Flights out of JFK tend to have the lowest award rates. Flights out of BOS have the most award availability.
- Round-trip award flights for these routes can only be booked via ANA Mileage Club, and availability can be difficult to find.
