## Where to book



### Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan

**Miles:** 55,000 one-way (BOS, BWI, JFK, YVR, YYZ); 70,000 one-way (LAS, PHX, SAT, SEA)

**Taxes, fees & surcharges:** \$49 from U.S.; \$65 from Canada

**Transfer partners:** Bilt, American Express (via Hawaiian Airlines HawaiianMiles)

### Emirates Skywards

**Miles:** 77,500–105,000 one-way

**Taxes, fees & surcharges:** \$43

**Transfer partners:** American Express, Bilt, Capital One, Chase, Citi

## Tips and tricks



- There are multiple award-booking options for Condor business class with Oneworld and other partner airlines.
- If you're in the Pacific Northwest, you can get a lower rate and find more business-class award availability flying out of Vancouver (YVR) compared to Seattle (SEA).
- Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan offers the lowest award rate, and points can be transferred from the Bilt Rewards program.
- You can also transfer [American Express Membership Rewards points to Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan](#) by first transferring them to Hawaiian Airlines, then transferring those HawaiianMiles to Mileage Plan.
- Emirates offers an option to upgrade to first class with miles.

## Step-by-step instructions



1. Visit the Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan site and log in to your account.
2. Enter the origin and destination airports.
3. Use the Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan award calendar to find the relevant dates.
4. Call Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan to verify the award space and hold the seats.
5. Transfer miles if needed (this usually happens instantly).
6. Book the flight.

**Notes:**

- There are up to nine business-class seats available per flight.
