

Tips and tricks

- There are numerous award-booking options for Royal Air Maroc business class, mainly with Oneworld partner airlines.
- Alaska Airlines offers the lowest award rate, but the out-of-pocket costs are much lower through American Airlines.
- You can currently transfer American Express Membership Rewards points to Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan by first transferring them to Hawaiian Airlines, then transferring those HawaiianMiles to Mileage Plan.
- While American Airlines and Alaska Airlines only have one business-class seat available per flight, British Airways has two seats available for most flights.
- British Airways Executive Club uses the Avios currency, as do Aer Lingus AerClub, Finnair Plus, Iberia Plus and Qatar Airways Privilege Club. If you have Avios with any of these programs, you can move those rewards to any other Avios program.

Step-by-step instructions




- 1. Visit the Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan site and log in to your account.
- 2. Enter the origin and destination airports.
- 3. Use the Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan award calendar to find the relevant dates.
- 4. Call Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan to verify the award space and hold the seats.
- 5. Transfer miles if needed (this usually happens instantly).
- 6. Book the flight.

Notes:

There are up to two business-class seats available per flight.
