Tips and tricks

.....

- There are numerous award-booking options for LATAM business class, mainly with Oneworld and SkyTeam partner airlines.
- You can get a 40% bonus when you transfer American Express Membership Rewards points to Virgin Atlantic Flying Club.
- You can also transfer American Express Membership Rewards points to Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan by first transferring them to Hawaiian Airlines, then transferring those HawaiianMiles to Mileage Plan.
- About half of the LATAM Boeing 787-9 aircraft have a newer, more desirable 1-2-1 cabin layout. However, use of this aircraft varies across routes.


Step-by-step instructions

- 1. Visit the Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan site and log in to your account.
- 2. Enter the origin and destination airports.
- 3. Use the Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan award calendar to find the relevant dates.
- 4. Call Alaska Airlines Mileage Plan to verify the award space and hold the seats.
- 5. Transfer miles if needed (this usually happens instantly).
- 6. Book the flight.

Notes:

• There are up to nine business-class seats available per flight.
