Tips and tricks

- There are numerous award-booking options for LOT Polish Airlines business class, mainly through Star Alliance partner airlines.
- Chase Ultimate Rewards points come with a 20% transfer bonus to Air Canada Aeroplan until Jan. 15, which means you could book this flight for as little as 59,000 Ultimate Rewards points.
- Additionally, holders of the Aeroplan® Credit
 Card from Chase get an extra 10% on the
 transfer of Chase Ultimate Rewards points to
 Air Canada Aeroplan. So cardholders could
 book this flight for as little as 54,000 Ultimate
 Rewards points.
- LOT has a "wet lease" from EuroAtlantic for a Boeing 777-200ER aircraft until spring. This is the best aircraft option, as it has a 1-2-1 business-class configuration.
- Lifemiles+ subscribers get a 10% discount on partner award bookings.

Step-by-step instructions



- 1. Visit the Air Canada Aeroplan site and log in to your account.
- 2. Enter flight details for the search.
- 3. Find the best date.m,
- 4. Cross-reference award availability on other booking sites.
- 5. Choose the best booking option for you.
- 6. Call to verify award space with an agent.
- 7. Transfer points if needed.
- 8. Book your flight.

Notes:

- There are up to nine business-class seats available per flight.
- Round-trip award flights for this route can only be booked via ANA Mileage Club.
- If booking through Avianca LifeMiles, it can be tricky to find space due to the program's clunky search tool.
- Instead, consider first checking for availability through United Airlines' website, where you can see availability month by month. You can then cross-check these dates with Avianca or Air Canada to book the cheaper rate.
