Tips and tricks

- There are numerous award-booking options for Royal Jordanian Airlines business class, largely with Oneworld alliance partners.
- The major benefit of having multiple booking options for Royal Jordanian is the ability to transfer miles from almost any program with a flexible currency.
- Citi ThankYou Rewards and American Express Membership Rewards both currently have a 20% transfer bonus to Qatar Airways Privilege Club. Your Qatar Airways Avios could then be transferred to British Airways to be used for this redemption.
- You can currently transfer American Express
 Membership Rewards points to Alaska
 Airlines Mileage Plan by first transferring
 them to Hawaiian Airlines HawaiianMiles,
 then transferring those HawaiianMiles to
 Mileage Plan.

Step-by-step instructions



- 1. Visit the American Airlines AAdvantage site.
- 2. Enter the origin and destination airports.
- 3. Use the American Airlines AAdvantage award calendar to find the relevant dates.
- 4. Call American Airlines AAdvantage to verify the award space and hold the seats.
- 5. Book the flight.

Notes:

• While American Airlines and Alaska Airlines only have one business-class seat available per flight, other Oneworld programs have up to two business-class seats available for most flights.
